PREPARATION FOR EXAMINATION: BRING OUT YOUR BEST

Timetable – It is essential that you follow a proper timetable. It ensures that you study every subject evenly throughout the week. You know your weak subject, so you can ensure that you are studying it repeatedly so that you are well prepared.

Making notes while studying – Make notes while studying a subject and highlight important keywords. This way one can just revise through these notes just before exams. Moreover, these highlights in your notes will help you remember important concepts faster.

Address your doubts unhesitatingly-If you find something difficult to comprehend then you must address that problem at once. Speak to your teachers about your difficulties and have your doubts cleared. Do not keep them for the last moment.

Solve Practice Papers – By solving these questions, you will get an idea of the time required to solve a problem and accordingly build speed.

Group studies - There is always someone or the other in the group who has understood the concept you are having a problem with. Avoid all distractions and chit-chats during group study.

Answering pattern/ Following Word Limit – You must work on your answering pattern. Ensure that you are not writing more than you need as it will kill your precious answering time. Nor should you write less as you will lose marks.

Eat Healthy and Sleep Well – This will enhance your productivity. Also **meditate for 15 minutes** every morning and evening and keep yourself **active through light sports**.

Confidence is the key- Be confident of your preparation; don't get confused with peers' random study discussions.
