ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY

For admission consideration, it is imperative that the child is formally registered with the school. Additionally, prospective students are required to undergo a comprehensive pen-and-paper test as part of the admission process. Admissions to Kindergarten classes will be purely based on student's and parents' interaction with the teacher and Principal. The following documents are mandatory for submission at the time of admission:

- A photocopy of the birth certificate issued by the Municipal Authority (original to be returned after verification).
- Copy of Aadhar card of the student and parent.
- Submission of the progress report and PEN (Permanent Education number) from the previous school.
- Furnishing the original School Leaving Transfer Certificate, where applicable. SLC to be countersigned by a competent authority if the student is from other state/board.
- Registration certificate of class IX/XI if the student seeks admission in X/XII.
- Two passport-sized photographs of the candidate.

Fees:

- Fee must be deposited in advance on quarterly basis by the 15th of April, July, October and January.
- The stipulated hours for fee payments are from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on all working days.
- A late fee fine of Rs. 50 per day will be levied for payments made post the 15th of the aforementioned months.
- Non-compliance with fee payments for two consecutive months will result in the student's name being struck off the rolls.
- To deposit fees kindly login to Campuspro app, user ID is your registered mobile no. and password is last 5 digits of your registered mobile number.

Withdrawals:

- A one-month notice in writing or payment of one month's fees in lieu is required for a child's withdrawal. Students leaving school in May are obligated to settle the fees for the month of June.
- The issuance of transfer certificates is contingent upon the settlement of all outstanding dues to the school.
- Students may face dismissal from the school on grounds of disciplinary issues, unsatisfactory progress in work or repeated detentions in a class.
