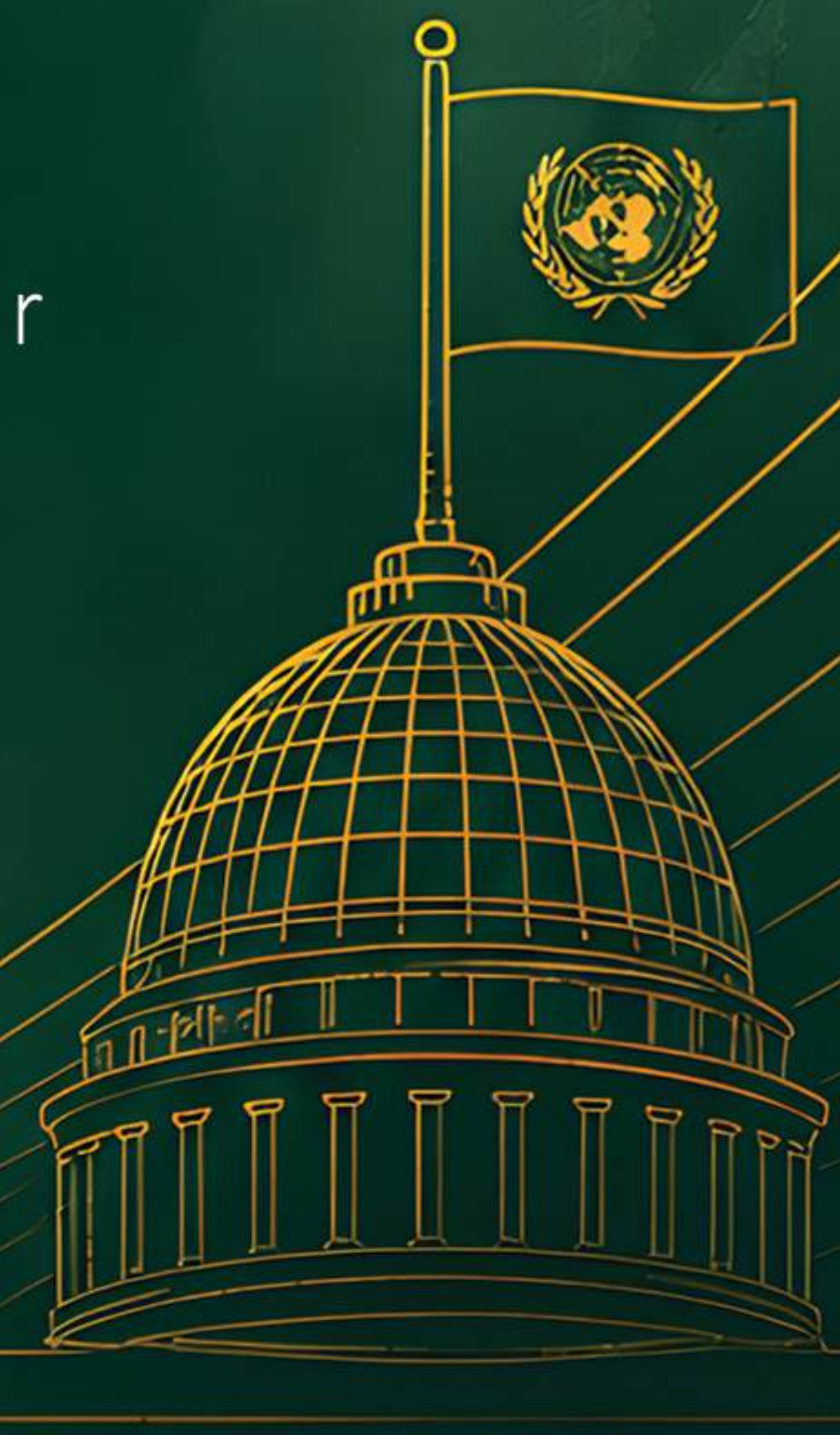

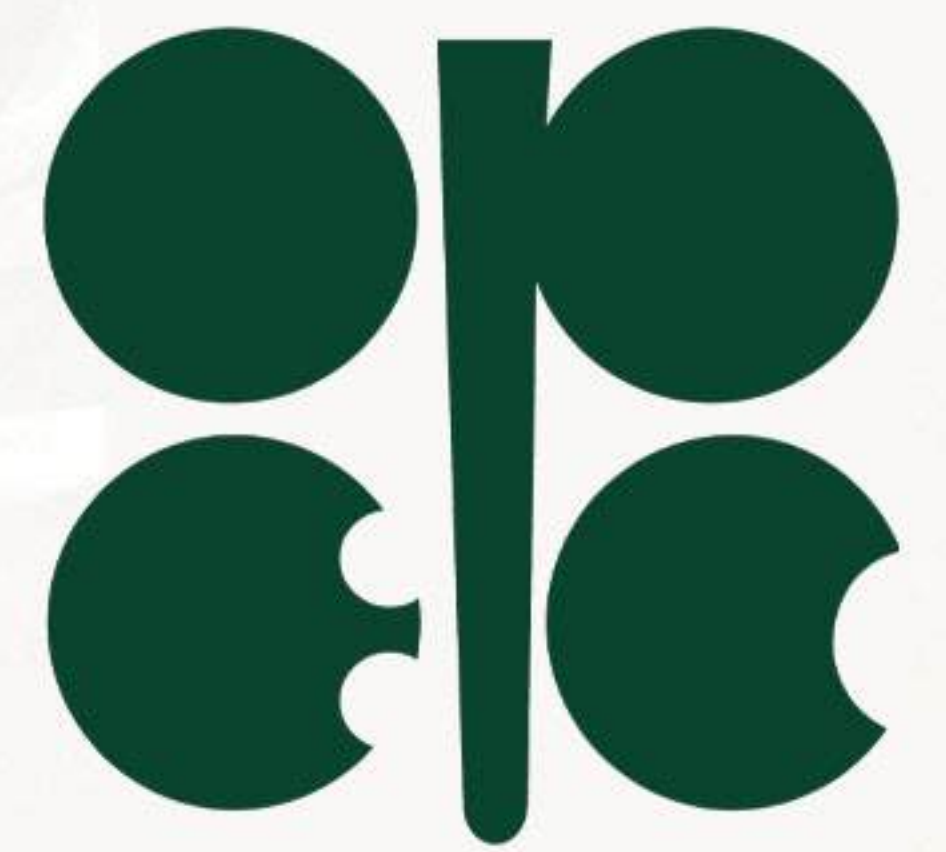

Agenda:

Deliberation on balance between State surveillance and the Right to privacy in digital age.



DIFFICULTY LEVEL: Beginner to Intermediate



COMMITTEE SIMPLIFIED:

This is a junior-level committee, designed for delegates in Classes VI-VIII who are developing their understanding of global issues and human rights. UNHRC is ideal for participants interested in fairness, digital safety, individual freedoms, and the role of governments in protecting citizens.

The United Nations Human Rights Commission (UNHRC) focuses on protecting and promoting fundamental human rights across the world. In this committee, delegates will explore how governments use surveillance technologies for security purposes, and how this can sometimes conflict with an individual's right to privacy. With the rise of digital platforms, data tracking, and online monitoring, important questions emerge: How much surveillance is necessary for safety? When does it become a violation of personal freedom? Delegates will discuss how nations can strike a balance between ensuring security while respecting the privacy and rights of individuals in an increasingly digital age.





AIPPM

ALL INDIA POLITICAL PARTIES MEET



Agenda:

Discussing the impact of proposed delimitation of constituencies on **representation**, **regional equity**, and **political power dynamics** in India.



DIFFICULTY LEVEL:

Intermediate to Advanced



COMMITTEE SIMPLIFIED:

This is an open-category committee, suitable for delegates interested in Indian politics, governance, and policy-making. AIPPM is ideal for participants who enjoy debate, strategy, and understanding real-world political scenarios.

The All India Political Parties Meet (AIPPM) simulates the functioning of Indian political discourse, where delegates represent different political parties and ideologies. In this committee, participants will examine how the proposed delimitation of constituencies can reshape political representation across states. Important questions arise: Will delimitation ensure fair representation or create regional imbalance? How will it impact political power and electoral outcomes? Delegates will engage in intense debate, negotiation, and alliance-building to present perspectives and propose solutions within the framework of Indian democracy.





CRISIS COMMITTEE

INDIAN INTERNAL SECURITY (RAW – IB – NIA)



Agenda:

Emergency session to address a coordinated internal security crisis involving **intelligence failure**, **terrorist threats** and **cyber warfare** in India.



DIFFICULTY LEVEL:

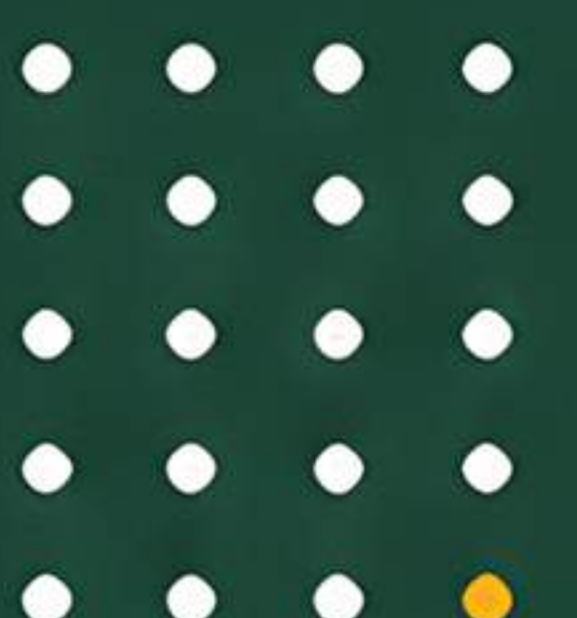
Advanced (Crisis Simulation)



COMMITTEE SIMPLIFIED:

This is an open-category crisis committee, suitable for delegates who can think quickly, make decisions under pressure, and adapt to rapidly changing situations. It is ideal for participants interested in security, strategy, and real-time problem solving.

This committee simulates a national security emergency where delegates take on roles within agencies like RAW, IB, and NIA. As the crisis unfolds, participants must respond to intelligence failures, emerging terrorist threats, and cyber warfare scenarios. Key questions include: How should agencies coordinate in times of crisis? What immediate actions are required to ensure national safety? Delegates will engage in fast-paced decision-making, drafting directives, and strategic planning to manage the situation effectively.





OPEC

ORGANIZATION OF PETROLEUM EXPORTING COUNTRIES



Agenda:

Deliberation upon ensuring global energy security and market stability in response to supply chain disruptions caused by the **US-Iran conflict** and **instability in the Strait of Hormuz**.



DIFFICULTY LEVEL:

Intermediate to Advanced



COMMITTEE SIMPLIFIED:

This is an open-category committee, ideal for delegates interested in global economics, geopolitics, and energy policy. It requires analytical thinking and an understanding of international relations.

The OPEC committee focuses on global energy dynamics and the role of oil-producing nations in maintaining market balance. Delegates will examine how geopolitical tensions, particularly the **US-Iran conflict** and **instability** in key trade routes like the **Strait of Hormuz**, disrupt supply chains. Important questions arise: How can countries ensure stable oil prices? What strategies can prevent global energy crises? Delegates will negotiate, form alliances, and propose policies to maintain energy security and economic stability worldwide.



SPECPOL

SPECIAL POLITICAL AND DECOLONIZATION COMMITTEE



Agenda:

The Invisible war: Shadows of Proxy Armies – Dismantling State Sponsored Terrorism, Narco-Crypto Financing, and Intelligence Operations Fuelling Middle East Chaos.



COMMITTEE SIMPLIFIED:

This is an open-category committee, best suited for delegates interested in global conflicts, security studies, and complex geopolitical issues. It requires strong research and analytical skills.

SPECPOL deals with some of the most complex and evolving global challenges. In this committee, delegates will explore how proxy warfare, illegal financial networks, and covert intelligence operations contribute to instability, especially in the Middle East. Key questions include: How do states indirectly fuel conflicts? What role does illegal financing play in sustaining terrorism? Delegates will work towards comprehensive solutions that address both the visible and hidden dimensions of modern conflicts.

Agenda:

Silenced by Age – Review of the constitutional provisions governing minimum age for parliamentary candidacy and its implications for youth representation in India.



DIFFICULTY LEVEL: Intermediate to Advanced



COMMITTEE SIMPLIFIED:

This is an open-category committee, ideal for delegates interested in law, governance, and constitutional debates. It encourages structured discussion and policy-oriented thinking.

The Lok Sabha committee simulates India's legislative process, allowing delegates to engage with real constitutional issues. In this agenda, participants will analyze whether current age restrictions limit youth participation in politics. Important questions arise: Should the minimum age be lowered? Will it strengthen democracy or compromise experience? Delegates will debate, draft bills, and present arguments while representing diverse political viewpoints within a parliamentary framework.

INTERNATIONAL PRESS



Agenda:

Open to Photographers, Journalists and Caricaturists.



DIFFICULTY LEVEL: Beginner to Advanced (Skill-Based)



COMMITTEE SIMPLIFIED:

This is a specialized committee for delegates in Classes IX–XII, ideal for creative individuals interested in media, journalism, and storytelling. It does not follow traditional debate formats but focuses on observation and expression.

The International Press acts as the communication hub of the conference. Participants will cover committee proceedings through articles, photographs, and caricatures, capturing the essence of debates and diplomacy. Key questions include: How can events be reported accurately and creatively? How can media shape public perception? Delegates will produce newsletters, reports, and visual content, playing a crucial role in documenting and presenting the conference narrative.

Registration Guidelines

Delhi Public School Karnal Model United Nations (DPS Karnal MUN 3.0) will be accepting school delegations only. We look forward to welcoming group delegations from institutions across the country. Each delegation must be accompanied by a faculty coordinator.

To complete the registration process, schools are required to provide the following details in the attached document:

- Name of the Teacher Coordinator
- Name of the Head Delegate
- Total Number of Delegates
- Previous MUN experience of participating delegates

Steps to Register



Phase I

– Registration Form Submission

- Please refer to the editable PDF titled 'Delegation Details' shared via email.
- The Faculty In-charge or Head Delegate must carefully fill in all required details in the document.
- The completed form should be submitted via email to mun2025@dpskarnal.com
- Our team will review your application and get in touch after assessing your profile. For school delegations, all communication will be conducted through the Teacher Coordinator.



Phase II

– Allotment & Payment

- After review, you will receive an official email containing the committee and portfolio allotments for your delegation.
- The Faculty In-charge and Head Delegate are required to verify all allotments carefully.
- A cumulative payment must be made for the entire delegation via bank transfer or UPI, based on the total number of participating delegates.
