

Late (Adv.) Dr. O.P. Yadav, the Founder and Director of RPS Group of Institutions, was a visionary in the truest sense of the word. Fondly called 'Bauji', the great scholar is credited with being among the pioneers in Haryana who lit the flame of education in the state bright and made the masses aware that the only way towards progress is through the realms of education. Taking inspiration from the dynamic persona of his father, Rao Pahlad Singh, he founded RPS Education Society in 1998 and steered Mahendergarh in the direction of becoming an Educational Hub that found recognition across the country.

Born in the village Kanina in Haryana on January 21, 1943, he was a child blessed with the spark to make impossible things possible. Actuated by his passion for serving his motherland, he initiated his career with the Indian Air Force in 1962, and dedicated 15 prime years of youth to the forces. This brave heart fought for the nation in the 1965 and 1971 Indo-Pak wars.

A true 'Karmayogi' as Dr. Yadav was, relinquishing Air Force never meant enjoying a slow-paced, post-retirement life. His fiery oratory found its rightful place in the Judicial System where he served the Mahendergarh District for 32 years. Bauji

was the epitome of courage and conviction. His life was an inspiring saga of commitment to education to which he devoted himself entirely and left an incredible legacy for generations to come. He was very popular with students and staff alike. He was always proactive and wanted to try out new ideas with a 'childlike' enthusiasm.

A man so noble, a man who has left a deep imprint on each and every person associated with him, a man who worked incessantly for the improvement of the education system, is no more with us, today. But he will forever remain in our hearts, guiding us from his abode up in Heaven.


SKATING RINK

RPS provides a specialized skating area where children have fun filled time learning and mastering this sport under the guidance of an experienced coach.




DANCE

GENERAL RULES

ADMISSION

Age Criteria: Nursery - child should be 3+ on 1st April of the year in which the admission is sought.

Prep - child should be 5+ on 1st April of the year in which the admission is sought.

Class 1 - child should be 6+ on 1st April of the year in which the admission is sought.

A student seeking admission to the school is registered only after the completed registration form is submitted to the school.

Pupils who have attended another school cannot be admitted until a transfer certificate duly countersigned by an authorized signatory from the earlier school is produced.

WITHDRAWALS

A student admitted to the school with all admission formalities furnished is refunded only the caution fee if he or she wants to withdraw from the school.

Withdrawal notice must be given within 30 days of the last date of the just completed term.

No refund of fees for withdrawal during the term.

If withdrawal is due to medical grounds acceptable to the Principal, 25% of fees will be refunded if the absence is for half a term or longer.

Those who leave the school in May must pay the fee for the month of June.

One clear calendar month's notice in writing or a

month's fees in lieu of such notice must be given before a student can be withdrawn.

Transfer certificate is not issued until all dues of the school are settled.

STUDENTS CAN BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SCHOOL ON THE FOLLOWING GROUNDS

Disciplinary: Unsatisfactory progress in academics.

Detention or repeated detentions in class.

As a rule, only students who can take the school leaving examination and are under 18 years of age will be retained on the school's rolls.

A student who fails twice in the same class will not be allowed to continue his/her studies at the school.

When a withdrawal occurs due to the above reasons, there will be no charge of a month's fee in lieu of notice.

Leave for going out of station must be approved in advance.

In case of an emergency, parents will be informed and must report to the Principal. Parents are not allowed to go directly to the classes.

OTHER RULES

Parents/Guardians must adhere to all school rules. The decision of the Principal is final in all disputes.

Parents/Guardians are expected to allow and

encourage their children to participate in compulsory curricular and extracurricular activities during their time at the school.

If there is damage to school property or loss of library books, the cost will be recovered from the parent of the student responsible.

All parents/guardians are advised to check the website regularly for timely information.

LATE ARRIVAL IN SCHOOL

The school gate closes 15 minutes prior to the school timings in summers and winters.

If students arrive after the gate has been closed, they will need to be accompanied by their parents.

Three late arrivals will result in the student being sent back home.

HOSTEL FACILITIES

RULES & NORMS

Mahendergarh, Hansi, Kosli, Behror & Kanina campuses have well-maintained AC/Non-AC hostels for boys and girls of Junior, Middle, and Senior classes. Recreation and indoor games are well provided in the hostels. Solar plants facilitate ever-ready hot water in the hostels, in addition to other modes of heating water. The hostels are managed by the hostel incharges and prefects. The Warden-in-Chief supervises the functioning of all the hostels. There are full-time maids looking after the children and managing the hostels.

- To enable the children to settle down quickly and properly, the parents of newly admitted children are not permitted to visit their wards during the first 30 days from the date of admission except in emergencies.
- Parents and other authorized persons may visit the students after 30 days from the date of admission on the third Saturday and Sunday of each month, between 11:00 A.M. to 5:00 PM. In exceptional circumstances, prior written approval of the Principal may be obtained to visit the child, once in a session, on a different day.
- Parents are not permitted to visit the classrooms, hostel, and dining hall of the school. They are required to wait for their wards in the Visitors Room.

MESS MANAGEMENT

A Mess Committee, composed of members from the Academic Faculty, Admin. Staff, Head Boy, Head Girl, Class



Representatives, and Mess Manager, plans and prepares a monthly mess menu and ensures that students get a palatable, nutritious, and well-balanced Veg/Non-Veg diet. A qualified, competent, and experienced Mess Manager supervises the preparation and service of food. Canteen facilities in the school premises are available on fixed days for different hostels.

GENERAL SERVICES

Services of a tailor, launderer, cobbler, and hairdresser (for children other than those of the Sikh Community) are available in the school.

HOSTEL RULES

- All students must arrive at or depart from the school on the specified dates, either with the school group or individually accompanied by their parents/guardians.
- Residential students are required to have only the designated clothing and books.
- Any pocket money given to students must be handed to the hostel-in-charge, who will distribute it to the students according to school rules and keep track of it.
- Leaving the hostel without prior permission is strictly prohibited, and anyone who does so will face strict consequences.
- Parents/Guardians can visit their children only with prior permission.
- Bringing unauthorized items or clothing is strictly prohibited, and any such items will be confiscated. Residential facilities are available for students from class 4 onwards.
- Local guardians, in the absence of parents, are permitted to visit or take the child twice a month on Sundays or school holidays, subject to the Principal's approval.
- During the terms, students are only allowed to leave for their siblings' weddings. For such occasions, the child can spend 2 nights at home plus travel time, provided we receive advance notice and clear travel instructions.
- Visiting home for family deaths or serious illnesses will be allowed at the Principal's discretion.
- Leave may be granted for specific student treatments if recommended by the school's medical officer.
- All leave requests must be made to the Principal by



parents or guardians. *No leave will be granted at the student's request. Leave requests via Fax/email will only be considered in urgent situations. No student can leave the hostel before 2 months.

- Parents are allowed to speak to their children on the hostel telephone once every 15 days.
- Hostellers are not allowed to bring transistors, iPods, cameras, MP3/MP4 players, expensive watches, or other costly items to school.


