Sub :- Continuity of Permanent Affiliation of the College.

Dear Sir/ Madam,

With reference to your application for the purpose mentioned in the subject cited above, I am directed to inform you that on the basis of the Inspection Committee report and as per recommendations of the Board of Inspection (BOI), constituted for this purpose, the University decides to grant extension of Permanent Affiliation to your college in the course(s) mentioned below for the academic session 2022-23, for the seats mentioned against the said course(s).

S. No.	Course(s)	Seats	Affiliation	Remarks of Inspection Committee
1.	LL.B. (3yrs)	240 Seats (Four Section)	Permanent	The College must appoint one more regular teacher for PG Programme by duly constituted Selection Committee prescribed for the purpose within three months.
2.	LL.M. (2yrs)	40 Seats (One Section)	Provisional	


Note:-

- The College should strictly follow the admission guidelines and syllabus prescribed by the University for all Law Courses, available on the university website.
- The medium of instruction shall be English for Five Years Integrated Law Programme.
- The provision of 10% (Ten Percent) seats for EWS category for all UG Law Course(s) will be strictly in accordance to the policy of Bar Council India (BCI) and with prior specific approval of BCI for the same.

Accordingly the college is strictly required to adhere to the following :

1. If the College already has a valid approval of BCI for the session 2022-23, it can start the process of admissions against the approved seats immediately after issuance of this letter. Also if the college does not have the valid approval of BCI for the session 2022-23, it is mandatorily required to obtain the BCI approval, or to deposit the requisite fee to BCI, within one month of issuance of this letter, for its inspection/approval for the session 2022-23 and proof of the same should be submitted to the University. The admission process can be started on compliance of the same.
2. The College may complete the admission process for the session 2022-23 strictly by 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2022 and no admission should be granted after this date. The classes for the session 2022-23 will commence from the 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2022. The students admitted in various course(s) for the session 2022-23 will require to be enrolled with the university latest by 10<sup>th</sup> September, 2022.
3. The necessary compliance with regard to remarks/recommendations made by the Inspection Committee must be ensured within the prescribed time limit, failing which, the proposal of the college for affiliation for the session 2023-24 will not be considered.
4. The University by virtue of its authority may exercise the powers to inspect the college anytime and if found violating the above mentioned norms, the college will be liable to face the consequences, which may also include the Deaffiliation of the College.
5. The proposals for Affiliation for the Academic Session 2023-24 will be invited in December, 2022.
