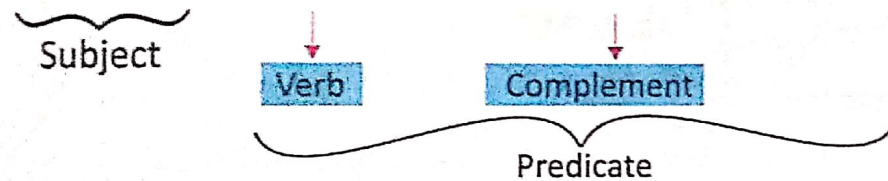

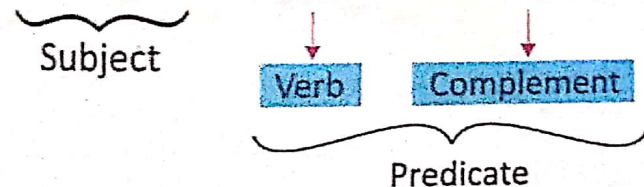
Linking Verbs
