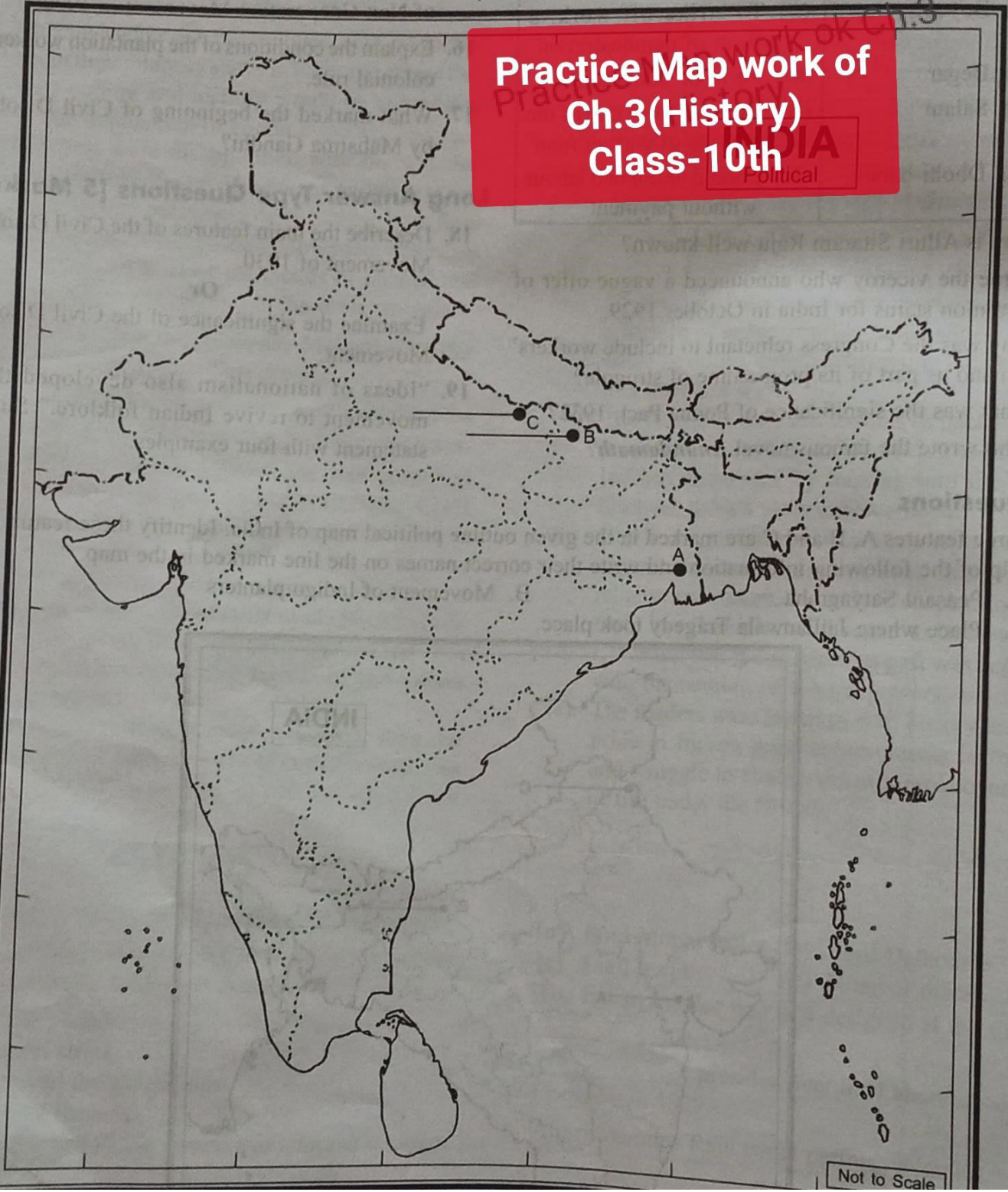


Three features A, B and C are marked on the given outline map of India. Identify these features with the help of the following information and write their correct names.

- C. Place where a police station was set on fire by enraged people.

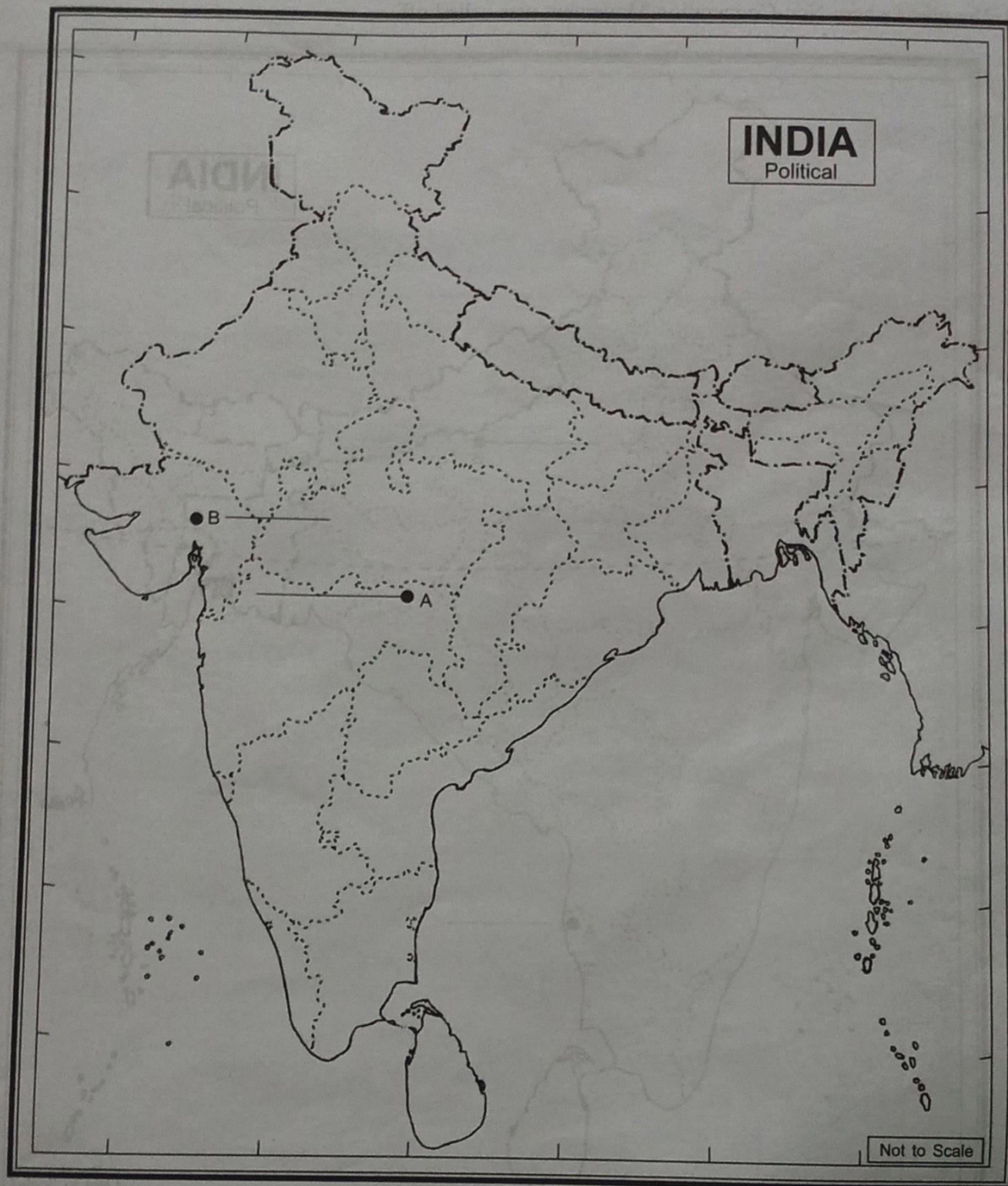

B. The place where the cotton mill workers Satyagraha was organised in 1918.

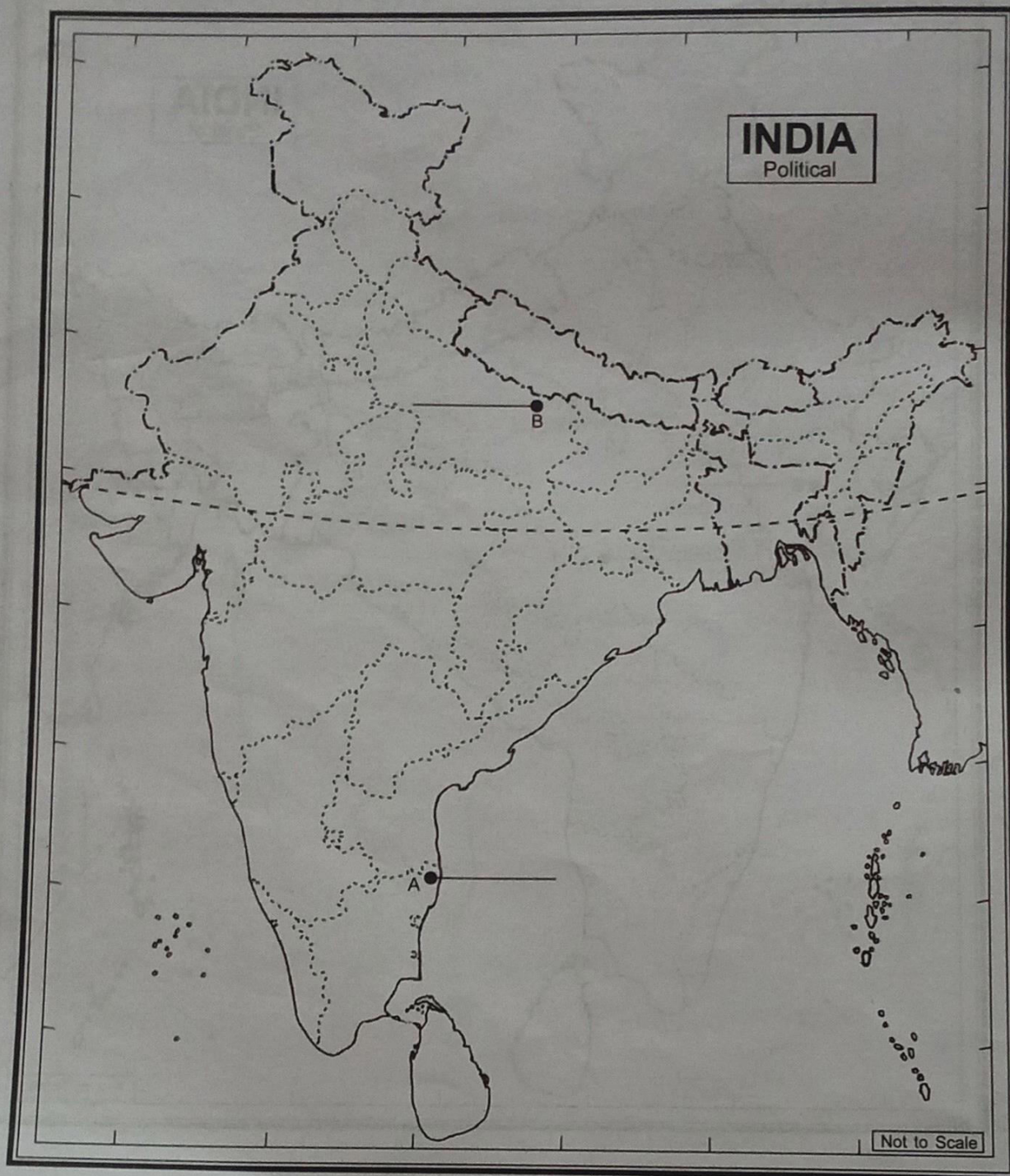


23. Two features A and B are marked in the political outline map of India.
