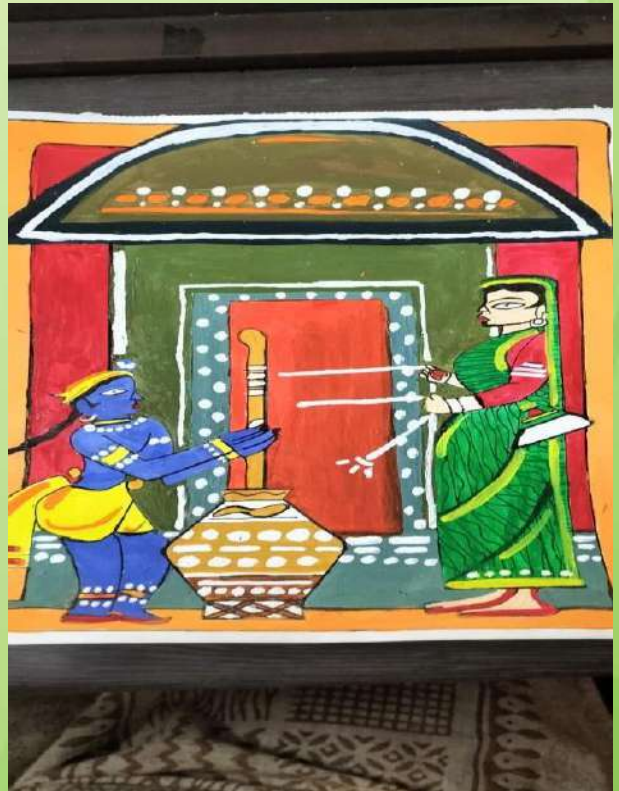

The workshop provided a valuable opportunity for Montessori students to learn and grow, laying a strong foundation for their social and emotional development.



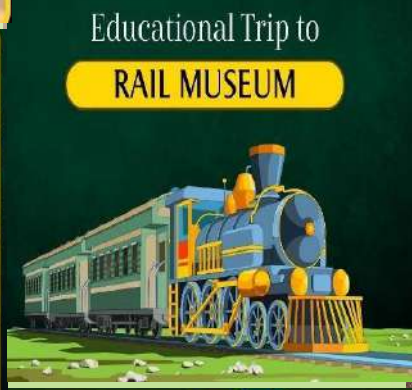


# Educational Excursion

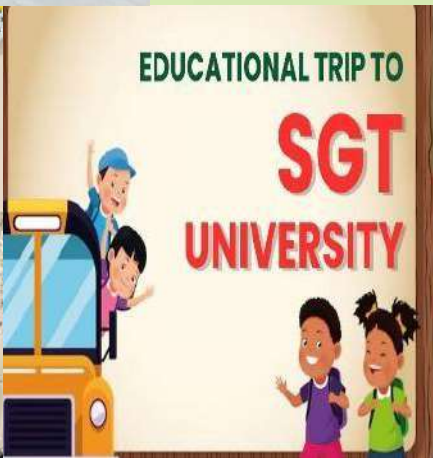




# Educational Excursion

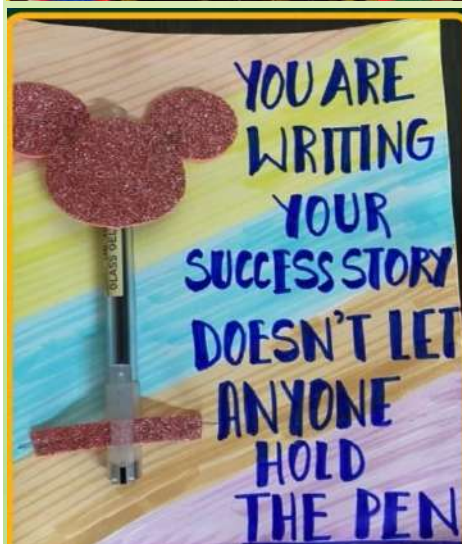
