


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RESPECTED CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE






POSITIVITY






Ramayana in the Modern Era

Our Halloween celebration was a spooktacular success filled with creativity and fun!


Students and staff dazzled in their costumes, enjoyed games, and showcased amazing pumpkin carvings.
